

How to use the Roundabout Safely and Avoid Fines at Pick Up

This car park is reserved for people with a **disabled parking permit** and for **volunteers** who are volunteering at this time.
 It is not okay to hover in this area and skip the queue when you see your child. It causes confusion for drivers doing the right thing and impacts considerably on the flow of traffic.
 This is not a safe place to tell your children you will pick them up from.

You cannot line up and wait along this side of Watt Street **AT ALL**. It is a **NO STOPPING** zone. If you stop here even for a moment and a ranger drives past you will be fined \$344 and lose 2 points. This area should be *completely* clear of cars until there is a space on the other side of Watt Street, in the pick up zone, at which time, the first car on Ruswell Avenue should drive into Watt Street, around the roundabout and into that spot.

This car park only for school **staff use**. Parents and children are not to walk through this area.

The pick up bay here is a **NO PARKING** zone. You cannot stop here for any more than 2 minutes, even if you are in your car and your engine is running. You should not move into this area until your child is in the waiting area and ready to get in your car. If you stop here for longer than two minutes, you may be fined \$187 and lose 2 points.

Ruswell Ave is a **NO PARKING** zone. If you queue in this area, be sure that you are not in the same spot for more than 2 minutes even if you are in your car and your engine is running and that you do not block driveways. If you pause in the same spot for longer than two minutes, you may be fined \$187 and lose 2 points.

You **CAN NOT** drive along Ruswell Ave and turn right into Watt Street. There is **NO RIGHT TURN** between 2:30 and 4pm.
